  - c) Five (5) years of professional experience in drafting reports, technical notes, and conducting analyses preferably on private sector related issues;
  - d) Three (3) years of professional experience in working on AU, RECs and other multilateral institutions, especially in Africa.
  - e) Proficiency in one of the African Union working languages (Arabic, English, French, Portuguese, Spanish or Swahili). Knowledge of one or several other working languages would be an added advantage.
  - f) Five (5) years of professional experience on regional integration, trade and economic growth within the context of the continent;





- g) Experience and knowledge of the AfCFTA Agreement;
- h) Experience in research and analysis in areas of concern to private sector participating in the Private Sector Engagement and to the Initiative itself;
